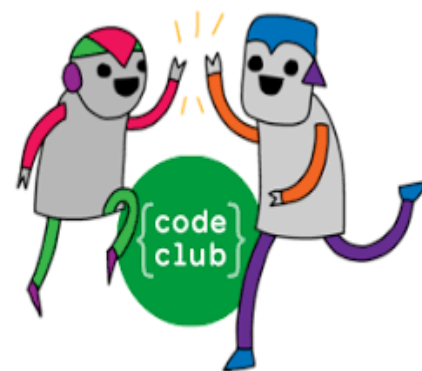
Is your school considering the introduction of Coding this term?
